

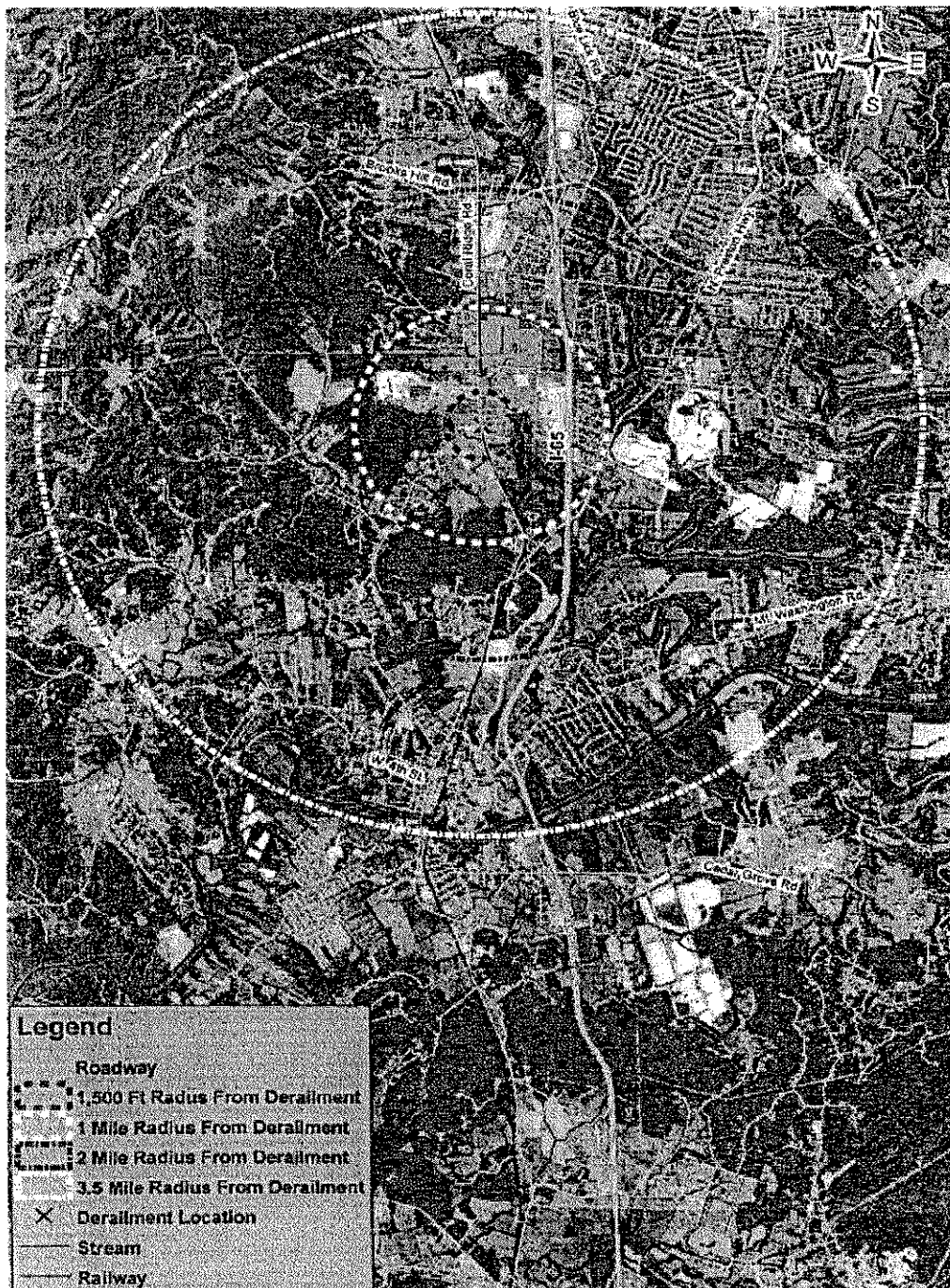
LEGAL NOTICE

If you owned property, lived in (as your primary residence) or were working in (primary employment/full-time job) the Brooks, Kentucky area between January 16 and 19, 2007, you could get benefits from a class action settlement.

A settlement of a class action lawsuit affects you if you were living in (as your primary residence), owned property in or were working in (as your primary job) the Brooks, Kentucky area between January 16 and 19, 2007. If you qualify, you may send in a claim form to ask for payment, or you can exclude yourself from the settlement, or you can object.

WHO'S AFFECTED?

People who lived in (primary residence), worked in (primary job) or owned property in the Class Area (shown in the diagram below) between January 16 and 19, 2007 are included in the settlement.



WHAT'S THIS ABOUT?

This lawsuit arises out of the train derailment, fires and environmental releases that happened beginning on January 16, 2007 near Brooks, Kentucky. CSX Transportation, Inc ("CSXT") was the operator of the railroad. GE Capital Services, Inc. and/or General Electric Railcar Services Corp. ("GE") leased one or more of the rail cars that derailed in the accident. The lawsuit claimed that CSXT and GE caused the train derailment, resulting fires and environmental releases. The lawsuit claimed that substances in one or more of the railcars were released and that the released substances escaped onto neighboring properties causing damage to property and to people. CSXT and GE deny they did anything wrong. This settlement is not an admission of wrong-doing or an indication that any law was violated.

WHAT CAN YOU GET FROM THE SETTLEMENT?

There is a settlement fund of \$3 million to pay claims of persons or entities who lived in, owned property in or were working in the Class Area between January 16 and January 19, 2007 where a train derailment, fires and environmental releases occurred. There is a limit as to the amount of damages you could receive. The settlement fund will also be used to pay class counsel attorneys' fees and various expenses.

HOW DO YOU GET A PAYMENT?

A detailed notice and claim form package contains everything you need. Just call or visit the website below to get one. Claim forms must be postmarked by **November 28, 2008**. The documentation requirements vary based upon the type of claim you submit. Please consult the detailed notice and claim form package for these requirements..

WHAT ARE YOUR OPTIONS?

If you don't want a payment and you don't want to be legally bound by the settlement, you must exclude yourself by **October 18, 2008**, or you won't be able to sue, or continue to sue CSXT or GE about the claims in this case. If you exclude yourself, you can't get a payment from the settlement. If you stay in the Class, you may object to the settlement by **October 18, 2008**. The detailed notice describes how to exclude yourself or object. The Court will hold a hearing in this case (*In Re Bullitt County Train Derailment*, Case No. 3:07-CV-24-R) on **December 15, 2008**, to consider whether to approve the settlement.
